Fretboard Flashcards

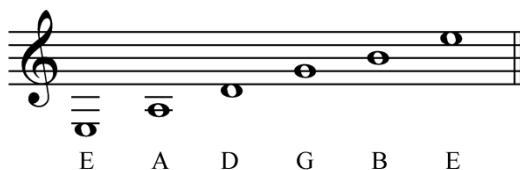
While there are many ways to learn the notes on the guitar fretboard, I recommend flashcards. This method involves learning the notes one fret at a time.

Keep the stack of fretboard cards with you and study them whenever you have a few spare minutes. These learning strategies can easily be done away from the guitar.

- Learn how to read music while learning the fretboard notes
- Learn each string at the same time
- Use repetition –the time-tested art of learning
- Discover patterns of notes throughout the fretboard that will help you in playing your music
