

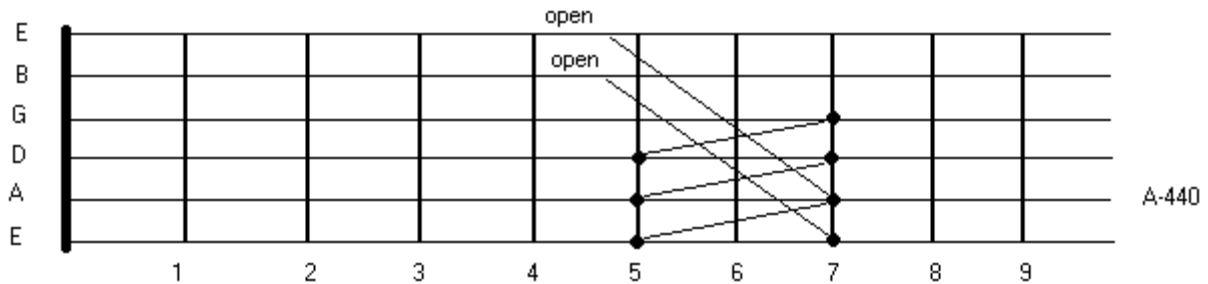

## Harmonic Tuning Method



### Directions:

Step #1: Tune the A-string to an A-440 tuning fork (the A-440 fork will sound two octaves above the open A-string).

Step #2: Tune the 5<sup>th</sup> fret harmonic on the low E-string to the 7<sup>th</sup> fret harmonic on the A-string.

Step #3: Tune the 7<sup>th</sup> fret harmonic on the D-string to the 5<sup>th</sup> fret harmonic on the A-string.

Step #4: Tune the 7<sup>th</sup> fret harmonic on the G-string to the 5<sup>th</sup> fret harmonic on the D-string.

Step #5: Tune the open B-string to the 7<sup>th</sup> fret harmonic on the low E-string.

Step #6: Tune the open high E-string to the 7<sup>th</sup> fret harmonic on the A-string
